### **NOTES:**

- 1. The Tribe is limited to 260 AF/year of net depletion in the Beaver Creek drainage, exclusive of exempted uses. Percent depletion reflects what percent of the diversion volume, for a specific use, must be counted against the net depletion cap.
- 2. Uses from the volcanic bedrock aquifer system are not to be counted against the 260 AF/year depletion limitation in the Beaver Creek drainage.
- 3. In the Upper Big Sandy Creek drainage, 67 percent of the volume diverted for irrigation is counted as a net depletion to the water system.
