

COST SHARE AGREEMENT
Between the
USDA FOREST SERVICE, HELENA NATIONAL FOREST
And the
MONTANA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES AND CONSERVATION
(MT DNRC)

The purpose of this agreement is to provide for a coordinated cooperative fire suppression operation on this fire and to describe the cost division. Following is the cost share agreement between the agencies identified above as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the **Statewide Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement #05-FI-11015600-014** executed between the parties on 3/10/05.

Structural Protection:

1. Identify the entity(s) that will provide structural protection and the rationale.
 - ◆ DNRC agrees to assume 100% of the costs incurred by Lewis and Clark County relating to structure protection within the Helena NF wildland fire protection area for a very small area at American Bar. *(These actions are defined in the 8/11/99, Northern Rockies Coordinating Group document titled, "Structural Fire Protection".)*
 - ◆ Within the direct protection area of the Helena National Forest, there are cabins on affidavit lands that will be protected by the forest.

Basis or Rationale for Cost Share:

Daily estimated costs in I-suite and the daily number of acres burned in each protection area were tracked for the cost share period. A final percentage to apply to the actual costs of the fire was calculated per the attached spreadsheet. The acres prior to the cost share are included because action was still being taken on these acres during the cost share period. ~~All costs prior to the cost share period will be bore by each agency.~~



Other conditions relative to this agreement (Special conditions, standard clauses, notifications, incident information, etc.)

- 1) Costs for nonexpendable property purchases by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 2) Administrative overhead costs such as agency personnel, support and services, not directly assigned or ordered by the incident, will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement and will not be shared.
- 3) Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged in unified fire suppression activities will not be included as part of this cost share agreement.
- 4) Agency-specific costs will not be shared.
- 5) Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdiction agency and will not be shared.
- 6) Responsibility for tort claims costs or compensation for injury costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
- 7) Daily acres burned by protection area and estimated costs will be documented and approved by the Agency Administrators or their designated representatives.
- 8) Sharing of final actual costs between the agencies will be based on actual incident suppression costs and each agency's proportionate share thereof as agreed to by the protection agencies.
- 9) Large fire overhead support provided by an Area Command, Buying Team, Expanded Dispatch, Mobilization and Demobilization Centers and Transportation Centers will not be shared in this agreement.
- 10) Per the Montana Cooperative Fire Agreement billing procedures, the parties to this agreement will determine the total costs of each agency. Each agency will bill for their costs.

This Agreement and the apportionment described are our best judgments of fair and equitable Agency cost responsibilities.




