¹ WMB reports and data are reviewed based on type and content before release to allow quality assurance for information and quantities contained within. The minimum level of review falls under 1 of 5 categories that determine the required number of staff that must review. Often this review may exceed the minimum level of review. All categories can, and often do, include external review by cooperating agencies or organizations involved in a project. This external review may be informal or adhere to the review, QA/QC guidelines of the external entity, but is NOT REQUIRED to meet WMB MINIMUM review requirements described above.
