The Green Meadow Temporary Controlled Groundwater Area was originally established on April 11, 2008 and extended three times. On December 10, 2013, R. Allan Payne, counsel for the Petitioners for the Green Meadow Controlled Groundwater Area, informed the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation that the Petitioners do not intend to pursue a permanent controlled groundwater area for Green Meadow and the Petitioners would not appear at any hearing set for that purpose. Petitioners requested that a hearing not be held and allow the Green Meadow Temporary Controlled Groundwater Area to expire on April 11, 2014.

As a result, the Department did not conduct a hearing and has allowed the Green Meadow Controlled Groundwater Area (41I-30022395) to EXPIRE.

Expiration of the Green Meadow Temporary Controlled Groundwater Area does not preclude future consideration of a controlled groundwater area under current existing statutes.
