RE: Notice of TEMPORARY EMERGENCY RULE pertaining to Renewable Resource Grant and Loan and Reclamation Development Grant Application Deadlines related to the COVID-19 pandemic.

To protect public health safety and welfare and comply with the emergency conditions of the COVID-19 pandemic – DNRC is extending the application deadlines for Renewable Resource Grant and Reclamation Development Grant Applications to **June 1, 2020**.

This notice is to advise you that the Conservation and Resource Development Division of the Department of Natural Resources and Conservation (DNRC) has adopted the following temporary rule regarding application deadline extended to June 1, 2020:

Emergency Rule No. 36-22-206.
