



## 2018 DNRC RRGL Application News

### What's new?

If you've applied to our program in the past, you might notice a few changes to the 2018 application for project funding. We've streamlined the online application to combine the RRGL project application for Government Entities and the Uniform Application Supplement. We have also changed the content of our applications to reflect current program requirements. Please let us know if you have any questions about this current approach.

### What application do you need to use for your project?

Projects that apply to the RRGL program for funding can use the Uniform Application or the RRGL Application for Government Entities (RRGL Project Application). The applications are used when a project wishes to use a combined approach to apply for up to six different funding agencies or when a project is only applying to the RRGL program.

#### 1. Uniform Application

Montana is unique to have an application that is shared with other funding programs called the "[Uniform Application for Montana Public Facility Projects](#)". This application contains the common forms, requirements, and checklists that must be submitted when applying for financial assistance to any of the funding agencies. The application can be submitted to any of the six programs involved. While this application has common forms, there is additional information that is required to complete your application. Public Facility projects using the uniform application will need to include a Uniform Application Supplement to have a complete RRGL application.

#### 2. RRGL Project Application

The RRGL program accepts applications for projects to enhance or develop Montana's renewable resources. This application would be used when a program is only needing

funding from the RRGL program to complete the proposed project.

### **How to apply?**

DNRC requires two forms of applications to meet the needs of multiple reviewers during the evaluation, scoring and ranking process. All grant and loan applicants (public and non-public facility) must submit all required materials online and by mail by **May 15, 2018**.

#### **1. Submitted Online:**

Online applications can be found and submitted at <http://www.fundingmt.org>.

The Uniform Application Supplement has been combined with the RRGL Application for Government Entities. When you open the funding opportunity and start an application, you will see forms called "All Applicants...", "RRGL only..." and "Uniform Supplement...".

- If you are submitting an application for government entities (RRGL project grant) you will need to complete forms titled "All Applicants" and "RRGL only".
- If you are submitting a Uniform Application you will need to complete forms titled "All Applicants" and "Uniform Supplement".

#### **2. Submitted by Mail:**

- a. One original authorizing statement.
- b. One unbound original application and all supporting documentation. Public facility projects will include a copy of the Preliminary Engineering Report (PER).
- c. Two compact discs (CDs) containing the application and supporting technical documents; and
- d. \$250.00 application fee.
