

I think I found a suspect Emerald Ash Borer? What should I do??

Try to collect a life stage of the suspect insect.

- Use a jar, container or plastic bag to capture the specimen.

If the specimen is alive, place it in the freezer to kill it.

Take note of the area where you found the suspect insect. Regulatory officials will need to be able to go back to the site to take additional samples/info.

- If possible, make a map or take GPS coordinates.



Report the suspect insect to your MSU
County Extension Agent or USDA APHIS
PPQ

It is helpful if you can email a quality photo of
the suspect insect and/or damage to the
tree(s).
