



COST SHARE AGREEMENT

Between

Montana Department of Natural Resources – Central Land Office, on behalf of
Jefferson County

And

United States Forest Service – Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest

This cost share agreement is between the agencies identified above, as negotiated for the following incident in accordance with the Statewide Cooperative Fire Protection Agreement #11-FI-110156000-006 executed between the parties for 2011-2015. The purpose of this agreement is to provide for a coordinated cooperative fire suppression operation on this fire and to describe the cost division.

Other conditions relative to this agreement:

1. Costs incurred by cooperators not engaged with the host agency or IMT in the fire suppression activities will not be included as a part of this cost share agreement.
2. Responsibility for tort claim costs will not be a part of this agreement. Responsibility for these costs will be determined outside this agreement.
3. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
4. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
5. Each agency will bill for their costs as outlined in the #11-FI-110156000-006 Cooperative Fire Agreement billing procedures.



Cost Share Methodology:

The costs of the Nineteen Mile Fire will be split based on an acreage percentage for protection. The rationale for the acreage methodology was due to the actions taken on the fire. Although line effort for suppression was higher on DNRC protected lands, aviation actions were higher on USFS protected lands. Taking this into consideration, line officers agreed an acreage split would be fair and equitable for both agencies. All actions taken on this fire will be included in the cost share total to be divided between Montana DNRC and the USFS.




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
