












## Consumptive Use Rights

Yellowstone National Park has a consumptive use water right totaling 174.9 AFY for park entrances, facilities, backcountry use, patrol cabins, and day use areas in the Yellowstone, Gallatin, and Madison River basins.


## Instream Flow

The ISF right for streams defined as Category 1 (headwatering on NPS reserved lands) = entire flow minus consumptive use rights defined in compact; for Category 2 streams (headwatering in Wilderness lands) the ISF right = entire flow minus any consumptive use rights of a U.S. agency; for Category 3 streams (headwater outside NPS reserved lands [but not Wilderness] and flowing in) the ISF right = entire flow, subject to special provisions outlined in Section III.G.3.c., 85-20-401, MCA; for Category 4 streams (special circumstance streams) the ISF right = entire flow minus any consumptive use rights defined in the compact and subject to provisions outlined in Section III.G.3.d. The ISF right ends at the most downstream point that the stream exits the park.


