

SPRING BEAR TIMBER SALE

NOTICE OF SALE

Department of Natural Resources & Conservation Timber Sale

The Spring Bear Timber Sale is located within Sections 4, & 10, T14N-R8W and Section 34, T14N-R9W, on the State's Clearwater Unit. Approximately 19,575 tons of sawlogs consisting primarily of Douglas-fir, with lesser amounts of ponderosa pine and lodgepole pine sawlogs, are offered for sale.

Sealed bids will be opened at the Department of Natural Resources & Conservation, 2705 Spurgin Road, Missoula, Montana on **March 5, 2015 at 2:00 p.m.** Bids may be hand delivered or mailed and will be accepted any time prior to the bid opening. **DNRC recommends that bidders contact the Trust Land Management Division (406-542-4300) prior to the bid opening to ensure that your bid has been received.** Bids must be accompanied by a deposit of **\$11,833.00**, representing 5% of the minimum bid of the sale in cashier's check, certified check, bank money order or bank draft to be applied to the stumpage for the successful bidder. Bid bonds will be accepted and, for the successful bidder, will be closed upon execution of the Timber Sale Contract and Timber Sale Bond.

The sale will be awarded to the highest responsible bidder. If the successful bidder is unable to execute the contract within **45** calendar days from the date the sale is awarded, the bid deposit will be retained by the Department as liquidated damages. The right is reserved to reject any or all bids.
