The Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law in this matter entered on September 18, 1974, are hereby adopted as the Final Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and the Final Order is hereby ordered.

ORDER

1. The application is granted with the following modification, that pumping be allowed from March 1 to October 30.
2. The applicant will notify the Department when he plans on commencing pumping operations in the years 1975 and 1976. Both the applicant and the objectors will observe the water table in their wells and will notify the Department of any abnormal and nonseasonal changes. If and when the Department receives notification of any abnormal and nonseasonal changes believed to be caused by the applicant's well, it will monitor the wells in the area. If it is found that the pumping by the applicant adversely affects the prior rights in the area, this order will accordingly be modified.
3. This permit is granted subject to existing water rights.
