PAST USE OF WATER

PROVISIONAL PERMIT 41F 58320-00 HAS BEEN USED TO SUPPLY THE TOWN OF WEST YELLOWSTONE WITH MUNICIPAL WATER. IT WAS ISSUED FOR A FLOW RATE OF 760 GPM UP TO 300 AF PER YEAR, DIVERTED FROM TWO WELLS LOCATED IN THE E1/2SW OF SECTION 27, T13 S, R05 E, GALLATIN COUNTY. THIS PERMIT IS UNPERFECTED. THE APPLICANT APPLIED FOR AND RECEIVED AN EXTENSION OF TIME UNTIL DECEMBER 31, 2026, TO COMPLETE THE PERMIT.

THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE POINT OF DIVERSION AND THE PLACE OF USE FOR PROVISIONAL PERMIT 41F 58320-00. THE NEW POINT OF DIVERSION WILL BE A WELL LOCATED IN THE SESENESE OF SECTION 33, T13 S, R05 E, GALLATIN COUNTY. THE NEW PLACE OF USE IS THE GROWTH POLICY AREA FOR THE TOWN OF WEST YELLOWSTONE, DESCRIBED GENERALLY AS SECTION 34, S1/2 OF SECTION 27, AND E1/2 OF SECTION 33, T13 S, R05 E, GALLATIN COUNTY. NO CHANGES ARE PROPOSED FOR THE PERMITTED FLOW RATE OR VOLUME.

In general, the department will make a preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 120 days of the date the application is deemed correct and complete. That date is currently unknown. If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will be published in the local newspaper and a notice will be sent to appropriators who, according to the department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have 45 days to submit an objection under § 85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
