PAST USE OF WATER

PERMIT 41J 58745 IS A WATER RIGHT INVOLVING FIVE WELLS. THE WELLS ARE LOCATED IN THE NWNWSESE, NESESESE, NESESESE, NWSESESE, AND SESESESE, ALL IN SEC 2 TWP 12N RGE 4E IN MEAGHER CO. THE WELLS ARE USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF IRRIGATION, MULTIPLE DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USES. ITS PRIORITY DATE IS APRIL 19, 1985. ITS FLOW RATE IS 270 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) AND VOLUME IS 84.6 ACRE-FEET (AF).

PERMIT NO. 41J 61460 IS A WATER RIGHT INVOLVING ONE WELL WHICH IS LOCATED IN THE NENENWSE SEC 2 TWP 12N RGE 4E IN MEAGHER COUNTY. THE WELL IS USED FOR THE PURPOSES OF IRRIGATION, MULTIPLE DOMESTIC, AND STOCK USES. ITS PRIORITY DATE IS AUGUST 20, 1986. ITS FLOW RATE IS 100 GPM AND VOLUME IS 51 AF.

PROPOSED CHANGE

APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE PERMIT NOS. 41J 58745 AND 41J 61460 BY CHANGING THEIR POINTS OF DIVERSIONS TO CONSOLIDATE FROM SIX WELLS TO ONE WELL. PERMIT NO. 41J 58745 INVOLVES FIVE WELLS AND 41J 61460 INVOLVES ONLY ONE WELL. THE SYSTEMS ARE MANIFOLDED TOGETHER. ALL OF THE WELLS INVOLVED ARE LOCATED IN SEC 2 TWP 12N RGE 4E IN MEAGHER COUNTY.

In general, the department will make a preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 120 days of the date the application is deemed correct and complete. That date is currently unknown. If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will be published in the local newspaper and a notice will be sent to appropriators who, according to the department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have at least 15 days and no more than 60 days (specific deadline will be identified at time of notice) to submit an objection under § 85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
