**PAST USE OF WATER**

THE EXISTING WATER RIGHT IS FOR 230 CATTLE DRINKING DIRECTLY FROM AN UNDEVELOPED SPRING. THE POINT OF DIVERSION IS IN THE NENWSE AND THE PLACE OF USE IN THE NWSE, ALL IN SEC 13 TWP 5N RGE 9E PARK COUNTY. ITS PRIORITY DATE IS DECREED TO BE JUNE 1, 1890. ITS FLOW RATE WAS CLAIMED TO BE 40 GALLONS PER MINUTE (GPM) AND A VOLUME OF 10 ACRE-FEET (AF).

**PROPOSED CHANGE**

APPLICANT PROPOSES TO ADD A STOCK TANK TO AN EXISTING STOCK WATERING SOURCE. THE ORIGINAL WATER RIGHT IS FOR STOCK DRINKING DIRECTLY FROM AN UNDEVELOPED SPRING. APPLICANT PROPOSES TO DEVELOP THE SPRING BY ADDING A PIPELINE AND STOCK TANK. THE TANK IS PROPOSED TO BE LOCATED 30 FEET FROM THE SPRING. THE DIVERSION (SPRING) IS IN THE NENWSE SEC 13 TWP 5N RGE 9E PARK COUNTY AND THE NEW PLACE OF USE WILL BE IN THE SESWNE SEC 13 TWP 5N RGE 9E MEAGHER COUNTY.

In general, the department will make a preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 120 days of the date the application is deemed correct and complete. That date is currently unknown. If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will be published in the local newspaper and a notice will be sent to appropriators who, according to department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have at least 15 days and no more than 60 days (specific deadline will be identified at time of notice) to submit an objection under § 85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
