WATER WAS DIVERTED FROM KELLY CREEK FOR DOMESTIC PURPOSES WHICH INCLUDED SOME LAWN AND GARDEN IRRIGATION. PLACE OF USE WAS THE NESWNW OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 33N, RANGE 18W, FLATHEAD COUNTY, MT. THE HISTORIC POINT OF DIVERSION WAS IN THE SENWNW OF SECTION 15, TOWNSHIP 33N, RANGE 18W.

**PROPOSED CHANGE**

THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO MOVE THE POINT OF DIVERSION FROM KELLY CREEK TO LAKE MCDONALD.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION**

THE COMMUNITY WATER SYSTEM PROVIDED WATER TO NO MORE THAN TEN DIFFERENT CABINS IN KELLY'S CAMP. THE APPLICATION IS ONLY FOR CABIN 6.

In general, the department will make a preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 120 days of the date the application is deemed correct and complete. That date is currently unknown. If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will be published in the local newspaper and a notice will be sent to appropriators who, according to the department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have at least 15 days and no more than 60 days (specific deadline will be identified at time of notice) to submit an objection under § 85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
