**PROPOSED CHANGE**

THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO CHANGE THE PLACE OF USE OF SEVEN WATER RIGHTS, ASSOCIATED WITH 5 EXISTING WELLS AND 1 REDUNDANT WELL YET TO BE DRILLED, TO REFLECT CURRENT DISTRICT BOUNDARIES.

FLATHEAD COUNTY RECENTLY AUTHORIZED TWO ADDITIONAL ANNEXATIONS INTO THE DISTRICT; THIS CHANGE REFLECTS THE NEW BOUNDARIES BASED ON THE ANNEXATIONS.

In general, the department will make a preliminary determination to grant or deny this application within 120 days of the date the application is deemed correct and complete. If the preliminary determination is to grant the application, the application will be published in the local newspaper and a notice will be sent to appropriators who, according to department records may be affected by the proposed appropriation. Individuals will have at least 15 days and no more than 60 days (specific deadline will be identified at time of notice) to submit an objection under § 85-2-308, MCA, after the application has been published in the newspaper.
