The following application has been submitted to change a water right in the State of Montana.

PAST USE OF WATER**SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS**

THE SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS WERE HISTORICALLY EXERCISED FOR IRRIGATION ON 138.63 ACRES AT A COMBINED FLOW RATE OF 1,102.25 GALLONS PER MINUTE. THE SOURCE OF WATER IS THE WEST GALLATIN RIVER, AND WATER WAS DIVERTED AT THE FARMER'S CANAL HEADGATE AND CONVEYED THROUGH THE FARMER'S CANAL TO THE E. MINDER LATERAL. THE HISTORIC PLACE OF USE IS THE NORTON RANCH, LOCATED JUST WEST OF BOZEMAN IN SECTION 9 OF T02 S, R05 E. A 1988 CHANGE WAS AUTHORIZED FOR ONE OF THE THREE SUBJECT RIGHTS.

GROUNDWATER CLAIMS

THE GROUNDWATER CLAIMS WERE HISTORICALLY EXERCISED FOR IRRIGATION ON 44.5 ACRES AT A COMBINED FLOW RATE OF 1.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND. THE SOURCES OF WATER ARE UNNAMED TRIBUTARY TO BAXTER CREEK; AND WASTE AND SEEPAGE, UNNAMED TRIBUTARY OF BAXTER CREEK -- BOTH GROUNDWATER. WATER WAS DIVERTED BY A SYSTEM OF DRAIN TILES AND SUNKEN CONCRETE HEADGATES. THE HISTORIC PLACE OF USE IS ALSO THE NORTON RANCH.

THIS APPLICATION PROPOSES TO PARTIALLY CHANGE THE PURPOSE AND PLACE OF USE OF STATEMENTS OF CLAIM 41H 30023118, 41H 30023119, AND 41H 30023120 (THE "SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS"). THIS APPLICATION PROPOSES TO RETIRE 26.4 ACRES FROM IRRIGATION UNDER THE SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE MITIGATION FOR A BIG SKY-AREA DEVELOPMENT'S MUNICIPAL USE OF WATER UNDER PROVISIONAL PERMIT 41H 30025398. UNDER THE SUBJECT RIGHTS, 39.0 ACRE-FEET OF WATER AT A RATE OF 47.58 GALLONS PER MINUTE WOULD BE LEFT INSTREAM IN THE WEST GALLATIN RIVER AT THE FARMER'S CANAL HEADGATE FROM MAY 1 TO OCTOBER 31. THE FARMER'S CANAL HEADGATE IS LOCATED IN THE SWNNW OF SECTION 11, T03 S, R04 E, GALLATIN COUNTY. WATER WOULD BE LEFT INSTREAM ALONG THE REACH FROM THE FARMER'S CANAL HEADGATE TO THE POINT WHERE INTERSTATE 90 CROSSES THE WEST GALLATIN RIVER IN THE N1/2NWSE OF SECTION 19, T01 N, R03 E.

GROUNDWATER CLAIMS

IN ADDITION, THIS APPLICATION PROPOSES TO PARTIALLY CHANGE THE PURPOSE, PLACE OF USE, AND POINT OF DIVERSION OF STATEMENTS OF CLAIM 41H 138898-00, 41H 138899-00, 41H 138902-00, AND 41H 138903-00 (THE "GROUNDWATER CLAIMS"). THIS APPLICATION PROPOSES TO RETIRE 8.78 ACRES FROM IRRIGATION UNDER THE GROUNDWATER CLAIMS IN ORDER TO PROVIDE MITIGATION FOR THE LOSS OF RETURN FLOWS DUE TO THE RETIREMENT OF 26.4 ACRES FROM THE SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS. UNDER THE GROUNDWATER CLAIMS, 9.75 ACRE-FEET AT A RATE OF 14.42 GALLONS PER MINUTE WOULD BE LEFT IN THE SUBSURFACE AS GROUNDWATER AND NO LONGER DIVERTED FROM JUNE 1 TO OCTOBER 31. THE NEW PLACE OF USE WOULD BE THE SAME AS THE NEW POINT OF DIVERSION: TWO POINTS, ONE ON AAJKER CREEK AND ONE ON BAXTER CREEK, AT THE DOWNSTREAM END OF NORTON PROPERTIES. THESE POINTS ARE LOCATED IN THE NWSNW AND NESWNE OF SECTION 9, T02 S, R05 E, FOR AAJKER AND BAXTER CREEKS, RESPECTIVELY.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

THE REMAINING ACREAGE UNDER THE SUBJECT RIGHTS IS PROPOSED FOR CHANGE TO A NEW PLACE OF USE AT THE CITY OF BOZEMAN SPORTS COMPLEX IN SUBSEQUENT CHANGE APPLICATION 41H 30103245. THE REMAINING ACREAGE UNDER THE GROUNDWATER CLAIMS IS PROPOSED FOR CHANGE TO MITIGATION TO PREVENT ANY ADVERSE EFFECT FROM THE LOSS OF RETURN FLOWS DUE TO THE RETIREMENT OF THE REMAINING ACREAGE FROM THE SUBJECT WATER RIGHTS.

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
