

TRIBE: Confederated Salish & Kootenai Tribes of the Flathead Reservation

UPDATE: July 15, 1986

Since the last progress report, the Commission has not met formally with the Confederated Tribes. However, on May 20 and 21, tribal council members and technical staff conducted a tour of the reservation to acquaint Commission members and staff with the Flathead Indian Irrigation Project.

Among other sites, the representatives of the Commission viewed several storage reservoirs, primary and secondary irrigation canals, numerous diversions on tributaries to the Flathead River, the pumping station on Flathead River, and Kerr Dam.

A date has not been set for the next negotiating session with the Confederated Tribes.
