*[Instruction: a person may choose to "swear" or "affirm." In making the choice, the person should strikethrough the one not desire, e.g. "I do solemnly swear (or affirm) that . . .".]*

See, Mont. Code Ann. 7-4-2203 – 2209. In addition, every court, judge and notary public has the power to administer the oaths or affirmations. See, Mont. Code Ann. 1-6-101.]*
