



Uniform Application Guidance for RRG Applicants Supplementary Instruction for Irrigation and Stream Restoration Projects

Overview

The Renewable Resource Grant (RRG) Program requires all RRG Project Grant applicants to complete and submit a Uniform Application for Montana Public Facility Projects with their online application. The information below is supplementary instruction for entities irrigation or stream restoration projects.

Guidance for Irrigation and Restoration Projects using the Uniform Application

Grant applicants with irrigation or restoration projects should complete the Uniform Application Sections as follows. **This is general guidance. For some projects or systems, applicants may need to complete additional fields beyond those identified below.**

Sections A-C

Complete following general instructions linked above.

Section D

Do not complete.

Section E

Complete this section to demonstrate whether the local government's current rates and charges are sufficient to cover the change in the system operation and maintenance cost due to project implementation.

Table 1 (Page 12)

- » Complete the "Current" and "Projected" columns for Fields 1, 2, and 10.
- » Under field 10, describe the system's rate structure(s).

Table 2 (Page 13)

- » Edit the Projected System Operation and Maintenance Cost categories to match the local government/system budget. For example, most entities will delete "Residuals Disposal".
- » The total in this table should add up to Field 1 in Table 1.

Subsection 1

Do not complete.

Subsection 2

Do not complete unless the local government is applying for an RRG Loan. If so, complete only the first table and do not complete Parts A-E.
