- 3. Agency specific costs will not be shared.
- 4. Costs for accountable, sensitive, and durable property purchased by each agency will be charged directly to that agency and will not be shared.
- 5. Non-suppression rehabilitation costs are the responsibility of the jurisdictional agency and will not be shared.
- 6. Each agency (including supporting agencies) will bill for their costs as outlined in the Montana Cooperative Fire Management Agreement billing procedures.

Aviation will be shared by the percentage of acres burned methodology as identified on the attached map. Aircraft with tail # 0PJ has been verified as committed to Revenue Fire via WildCAD log from 1500-1807 on 9/29/2024 and will be shared by the percentage of acres burned.

All other expenses will be paid for by the Agency which requested the Resource under a, You Order You Pay methodology. Resources identified by the requesting Agency are identified below and the requesting/ordering Agency is 100% responsible for all costs associated with these Resources.
