





...of forestland in MT which contain significant forest health issues or high wildfire risk.



Timeline:

Aug 1st: RFP published.

Aug. 31st: Pre-proposals are due by 5pm.

Sept. 15th: Unique application link sent to the point of contact for each proposal.

Oct. 31st: Application period closes at 5:00pm.

Nov. 2023 : Review, scoring, and selections will be completed.

Funded projects should plan to begin in the spring of 2024.

Successful applicants will be notified in early winter 2023.

A pre-proposal is required to receive a link (upon approval) to the competitive grant application.

If you are part of a multi-party project, only one person within the group needs to submit a pre-proposal.

Minimum request: \$50,000

Maximum request: \$300,000*

*multi-party projects, meaning more than one grant recipient, can apply for up to \$500,000
