THE APPLICANT PROPOSES TO DIVERT WATER FROM THE YELLOWSTONE RIVER BY MEANS OF A STEM AND HANDWHEEL HEADGATE OPENING INTO A THREE-FOOT CULVERT ON THE NORTHWEST BANK OF THE YELLOWSTONE RIVER IN GOV'T LOT 10 NWSESW OF SECTION OF 34, T6S, R7E, IN PARK COUNTY. THE WEST CREEK RANCH LLC, CURRENTLY USES THE DIVERSION UNDER IRRIGATION STATEMENT OF CLAIM 43B 190625-00. WATER IS CONVEYED FROM THE POINT OF DIVERSION THROUGH A DITCH TO A PUMP SITE IN THE SW OF SECTION 34, T6S, R7E, WITHIN PARCELS 4 AND 4A OF CERTIFICATE OF SURVEY 1400. AT THE PUMP SITE THERE ARE TWO SEPARATE PUMPS. BOTH PUMPS WERE INSTALLED BETWEEN 1998 AND 2004. FROM EACH OF THE PUMPS, WATER IS PUMPED FROM THE DITCH INTO A SYSTEM OF PIPELINES, WHICH SUPPLIES WATER TO THE VARIOUS PIVOTS AND SPRINKLER SYSTEMS ACROSS THE PLACE OF USE. EXCESS WATER NOT DIVERTED AT THE PUMPING SITE IS RETURNED TO THE YELLOWSTONE RIVER VIA A NATURAL CHANNEL/DITCH.
