- 2. Vote: AgriMet Funding for 2 stations Round Butte & St Ignatius with funding through the CITT.

Approximately \$1,600/year/station for 10 years - \$32,000

- *Motion approved by 5 of 5 members
- 3. Vote: Reservoir water level monitoring project funding for Phases II & III per approved workplan.

Phase II for six installations - \$69,175

Phase III for five installations - \$96,160

- *Motion was passed to approve funding for both Phase II and III in the amount of \$165,335.
- *Motion approved by 5 of 5 members
- 4. Vote: Move CITT website information from https://cskt-montana-citt.org/ to https://cskt-montana-citt.org/ to https://cskt-montana-citt.org/ to federated-salish-and-kootenai-tribes-compact/cskt-montana-compact-implementation-technical-team until a future date in which the CITT.org site may be revamped to be additionally formalized as part of impending rule change needed to accommodate the Effective Date.

- 5. Vote: Recommend finalization of findings of Reservoir Bathymetry Project Discussed tabling vote pending a technical meeting to further discuss the findings. State committed to organize discussion within 8 weeks of this decision.
 - *Table vote: Approved by 5 of 5 members
