Reserved Right Summary

-The Agricultural Research Service operates the Sheep Experiment Station to develop increased efficiencies for raising sheep and improve sustainability of rangeland ecosystems. Most of the station is located in Idaho, but 16,600 acres are located in Montana's Centennial Mountains and primarily used for summer grazing.

-Existing uses up to 11.72 acre-feet per year from surface water for stock watering.

-Future uses up to 15 acre-feet per year for domestic, research, dust abatement, reclamation, and other administrative purposes from surface or groundwater. Emergency fire suppression is also authorized.
